- Be sure to spend this time focused on intentional prayers.
 - If you have a live video feed, you are praying with your eyes open so that you can watch what is going on in real-time.
- Each pray-er is expected to come into the prayer time with clean hands and a pure heart.
- Remember that this is not a time to pray for personal needs.
- Your prayers are to be pointed directly toward:
 - The needs of the church
 - The congregation's response to the pastor's teaching
 - And the way that they will life-out his teaching this week.
- In addition to the following pages add your weekly bulletin, monthly newsletter, etc., anything that will give you specific areas to pray, that focus on your church and its needs.
- Additional prayer helps should include lists of your Sunday School teachers names, church staff, including pastors' assistants, volunteers, church supported missionaries, etc.
